Functions: Certainty and Uncertainty

EXPRESSING CERTAINTY

When you are sure that something will or will not happen in the future, use these expressions.

For example to the question:

"Will John pass the exam?"

you may respond as follows:

Yes,	I'm	absolutely sure quite sure certain positive	he will.
	cert	initely. ainly. course.	

or

No,	II III	absolutely sure quite sure certain positive	he won't.
		nitely not. ainly not.	
	of c	ourse not.	

EXPRESSING UNCERTAINTY

When you are not sure whether something or someone will or will not happen, use the following expressions.

For example, to the question:

"Will John follow a career in business?"

you may respond as follows:
